COLLEGE PROFILE

Mayang Anchalik College, a Degree (Arts) College, which was established in 1992, in the village Rajamayang, is the only seat of higher learning in the western part of the district of Morigaon, Assam. The College is the product of hard works and dedication of the common people with the visionary leadership and commitment of the academic luminaries of this region. The institution, which came into being in an economically and educationally backward and flood-prone region like Mayang, recently the college celebrated its silver Jubilee on August 2017. The College is permanently affiliated to the University of Gauhati, Guwahati and the Core Subjects offered by the University for the college are: Economics, History, Political Science, Education and Elective Assamese. Major Courses are also available in all the subjects. The College has been included under sections 2(f) & 12 (B) of the UGC Act 1956. Started with a few copies of books in its library, the College has now a holding of over 14,000 collections of both textbooks and references in its central library and has subscribed to many journals and newspapers. Now, the College is the Centre of Excellence in imparting and expanding education among the rural poor students. The College library is dedicated to the honourable founder secretary of the College Late Dipan Ch. Nath. The region of Mayang, previously known for its mystic quality, is a growing urban area which is one-hour drive from Guwahati. What attracts more is the strategic geographic location of Mayang Anchalik College between the mighty Brahmaputra on the North and

the Pobitora Wildlife Sanctuary on the south. Fringed by beautiful lush green countryside, the sprawling campus of the College always provides an idyllic academic atmosphere at the College. Situated at a distance of 42 Km from Morigaon College, 35 Km from Jagiroad College, 35 Km from Dimoria College and 33 Km from Narengi Anchalik College, Guwahati, Mayang Anchalik College is a preferred destination of higher education for the rural poor students. All roads to the College are pacca (black topping). Since its inception, the College has been rendering quality higher education to the students,' following participatory methods in a friendly and learner-centered atmosphere.

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The Mayang Anchalik College is situated in big village Rajamayang, Morigaon, Assam with a naturally green environment. The College is remotely located and serves a large rural area the average distance of the neighbouring colleges from Mayang Anchalik College is 35 K.M. The college has 33 bighas of land which include a big playground in front of the college. The college has a three storied academic building of 54200 sq. ft. floor area where all the departments and the library is situated. There is an indoor stadium of 9600 sq. ft, which is complete with all the necessary equipment. There is a separate building for a mini auditorium (3520 sq. ft. floor area), Gymnasium (1600 sq. ft. floor area) and an administrative block (3680 sq. ft. floor area). The college also has one 60 (sixty) seat capacity, fully furnished, Girls hostel. There is a registered alumni association in the college which is actively involved in the development process of the college. Thus, the college has a tremendous scope for further development.

The college had 731 students in the academic year 2018-19. The college has 21 faculty members of which, 04 have Ph.D. and 16 have M.Phil. Degree. The result of the college (final batch 2019) is good and is more than the University average.

We visited the principal's office, library, indoor stadium, girls' hostel and all the academic departments of the college. From the data provided and physical observation, it is clear that the college maintains its records properly. The attitude and behaviour of all the members are excellent. The College has huge potential of contribute of the nation building process.

By observing all the parameters, the following are made for overall improvement of the academic ecosystem of the college.

1. The College should increase if academic involvement with other institutions and the society at large through MoUs with different organisations/institutes. This will not only lead to knowledge sharing, but will also increase the visibility of the college.
2. The College may develop itself into a hub of socio-economic development, being located at a remote area that is economically and educationally backward the college should organise health awareness camp, including health check-up and free distribution of medicines, legal awareness camp etc.

3. The MAC is ideally located to contribute to the development of eco-tourism with the Pobitora Wildlife Sanctuary in its neighbourhood. Academic training programmes focussing on the tourism sector may be introduced.
4. Adequate facilities are necessary for this remotely located college so that students do not suffer the burden of daily communication over long distances. The college may therefore consider increasing boarding facilities.
5. More seminars, workshops and popular lectures like Faculty Development Programme, Intellectual Property Rights, Student Development Programme, Life Skill Programme, Soft skill Programme etc. are to be conducted.
6. Gymnasium and Yoga centre may be established.
7. Established a Skill centre for better emphasis on skill development. The management of the college shall take appropriate measures on the abovementioned recommendations.
8. The college is located at a historical place surrounded with heritage sites. Mayang Anchalik College make take initiative for increasing conservation and preservation of these sites.
9. The college must immediately improve the student feedback mechanism.
10. The faculty members need to engage in research and other needs of higher learning as much as possible.
11. The college need to participate in the NIRF ranking process and get NAAC accreditation at the earliest.
