

Dibru-Saikhuwa Wildlife Sanctuary

- **Dibru-Saikhowa National Park** is a national park in Assam, India, located in Dibrugarh and Tinsukia districts. It was designated a Biosphere Reserve in July 1997 with an area of 765 km² (295 sq mi), including a core area of 340 km² (130 sq mi) and a buffer zone of 425 km² (164 sq mi).
- It is located at about 12 km (7.5 mi) north of Tinsukia town at an average elevation of 118 m (387 ft), ranging from 110 to 126 m (361 to 413 ft). The park is bounded by the Brahmaputra and Lohit Rivers in the north and Dibru river in the south.

Fauna

- **Mammals:** 36 mammal species have been recorded, of which 12 are listed in Schedule 1 of the Wildlife (Protection) Act of 1972.—Species include Bengal tiger, Indian Leopard, clouded leopard, jungle cat, sloth bear, dhole (raang kukur), small Indian civets (jahamal), Malayan giant squirrel, Chinese Pangolin (ban rau), Gangetic dolphin, slow loris (lajuki bandar), pig tailed macaque (short tailled small monkey), Assamese macaque, rhesus (small) macaque, capped langur, Hoolock gibbon, Asian elephant, wild boar (bara gahari), ambar deer, hog deer, barking deer, Asiatic water buffalo, and feral horse.

Reptiles

- Two species of monitor lizard, eight turtle species and eight snake species have been recorded.

Birds

- Birds recorded include greater adjutant, Jerdon's babbler, black-breasted parrotbill, puff-throated babbler, lesser adjutant, Sarus crane, Bengal florican, spot-billed pelican, white-necked stork, black stork, black-necked stork, white-bellied heron, glossy ibis, fulvous whistling-duck, bar-headed goose, common shelduck, white-winged duck, Indian spot-billed duck, Himalayan griffon, white-tailed eagle, Pallas's fish-eagle, grey-headed fish eagle, greater spotted eagle, white-backed vulture, slender-billed vulture, lesser kestrel, brown fish owl, great pied hornbill, spotted redshank, spotted greenshank, Indian cormorant (pani Kawri), grey heron, purple heron, black-crowned night heron, yellow bittern (konamachuri), Asian openbill, greylag goose, crested serpent-eagle, white-winged wood duck, pale-capped pigeon.
