 It covers the regulation of food production, food control, food safety, quality, distribution and conumption.

Food Laws

- The central government under the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare has established a body known as "Food Safety and Standards Authority of India" to perform the function assigned under "The Food Safety and Standards Act".
- This consolidates various acts that were handled food related issues in various Ministries and departments.
