The Committee had discussions at length and the following resolutions have been made:


* The meeting has resolved to motivate the students to raise their complaints in writing without any fear.


The minutes of the last meeting of ICC was read out by in-charge Dr. Biswika Kalita and having found all the relevant matters discussed

for the same.






ICC has organised a National Girls child day today. The programme started by the chairperson, Dr. Mahananda Barua, who informed the gathering about the significance of the National Girls child day. In-charge Dr. Prisli Kalita highlighted the
