Report of the Programme:

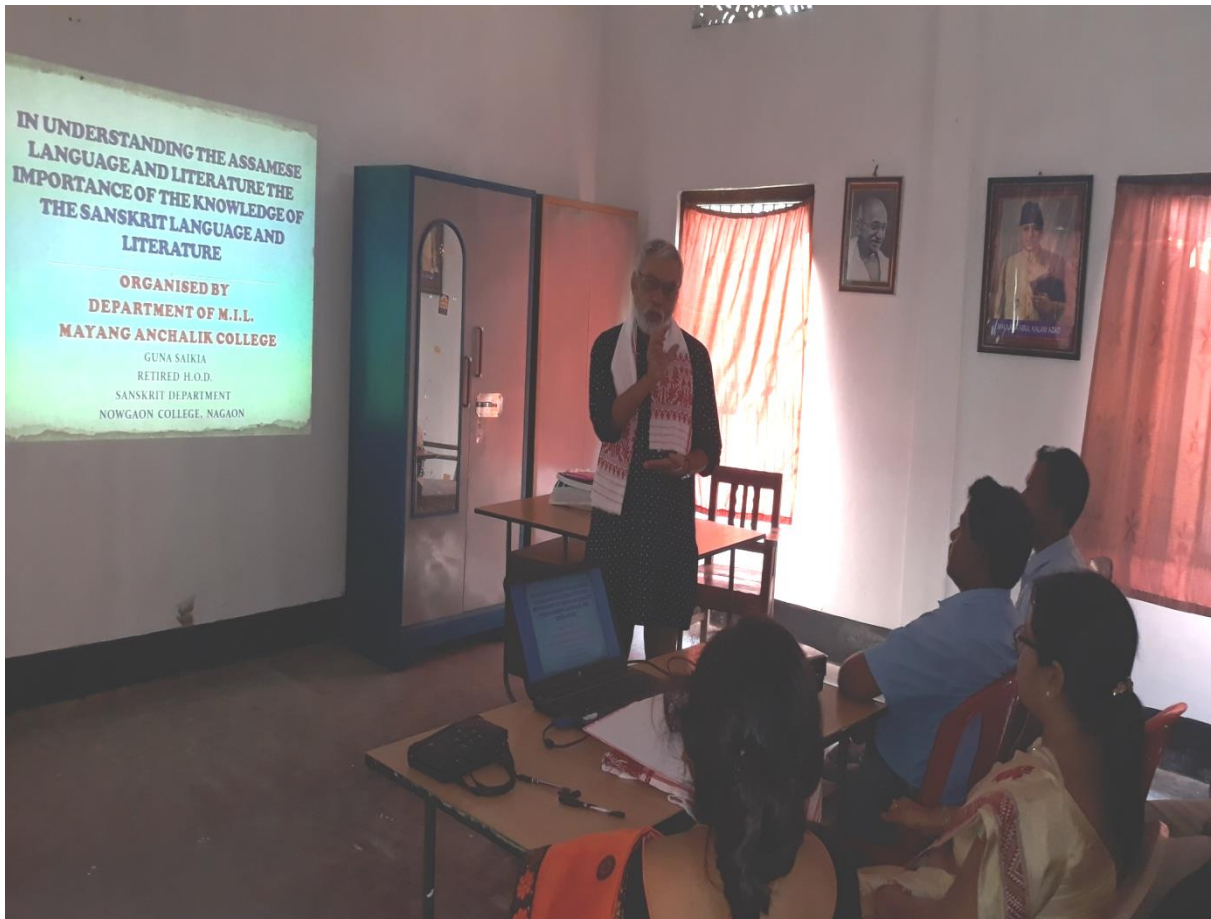

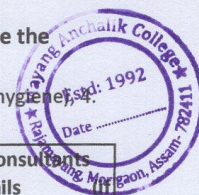
